

# GREATER SUSQUEHANNA VALLEY VACCINE GUIDE

1. If a person is [Phase 1a](#) (healthcare worker, people aged 65+ and/or people aged 16-64 with an indicated medical condition), they can make an appointment through their doctor, at a pharmacy or through one of our local hospitals.
2. GSV Task Force is making a list of organizations/employees that fall into [Phases 1b and 1c](#) and want a vaccination. Once supply is available, clinics will be scheduled.
3. Once all people in Phase 1 are vaccinated, clinics/appointments will be opened to everyone. More information will be shared when that time comes.

Please remember:

- **Be patient.** Supply remains very limited and information is coming out daily. The Task Force will share information as soon as it is available.
- **Keep your appointment!** If you need to cancel, please cancel as soon as possible.
- **Schedule only one appointment per person.** While “vaccine shopping” may seem helpful, this can result in others being unable to schedule. It also risks wasting vaccine.
